PT220 Quick Start Guide


Instructions how to get started with PT220 evaluation kit in three simple steps

Setup Unit

Open the SIM card cover and insert a SIM card with its contact surfaces upwards and cut corner towards the PT220. NOTE: SIM card PIN code request must be disabled before inserting the card. Open the USB connector cover and connect the USB cable to a power source. PT220 starts automatically when the USB port is powered.



After initial USB power start PT220 can be turned off and on by pressing the Power button. LED1 (Power) blinks green when battery is OK, blinks red when battery is low and is lit red when charging. LED2 (GPS) is lit when no GPS fix is available and off when valid fix is available. LED3 (GSM) is lit while unit is not registered to a network, blinks when acquiring server access and turned off when server connection is established. LED2 and LED3 are off and LED1 (Power) blinks when the unit has GPS fix available and it is reporting to the server.



View reports from unit

Click Unit ID to open a unit page. The unit should start reporting within 2 minutes from entering phone number and APN configuration.
